We do not sell cuttings, all our plants are rooted and then moved onto a 7cm pot to establish, in January and February the plants will be available at £1.50 each. March and April they will be £1.80. May onwards £2. Please ask regarding discounts on large purchases.

Whips will be sold from February. Standards and fuchsia baskets will be ready from Saturday April 29<sup>th</sup>. Prices throughout will depend on size. Larger plants may be available throughout the season - please ask.

From June 4<sup>th</sup> until June 24<sup>th</sup> - there will hopefully be displays of fuchsias in flower - please come and have a browse and get ideas for next year. It is an unbeatable opportunity to see fuchsias that you will not see at shows etc.
